Unless otherwise noted, all programs include lunch, coffee and tea, dessert, and any materials. RSVPs preferred.

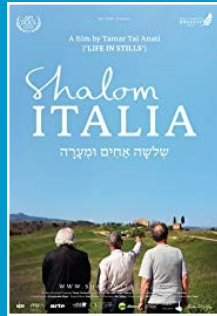

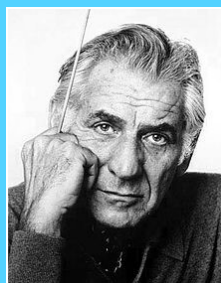
**WEDNESDAY, August 1, 2018 — 11:00 am**
